



Group seeks input on housing for disabled

Disability Network/Lakeshore and its community partners are hosting local housing input sessions. Feedback from the community will be used to identify unmet countywide housing needs such as affordability, accessibility, individual supports, and access to public amenities for people with disabilities.

The input sessions are part of a year-long project that has included surveys and focus groups with housing providers, local organizations, people with disabilities, parents, and caregivers. Results of the study will be used to develop and prioritize housing solutions that will be shared with decision-makers.
